AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to increasing the income eligibility threshold for the tuition assistance program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (ii) of paragraph a of subdivision 3 of  
2 section 667 of the education law, as amended by section 1 of part B of  
3 chapter 60 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows:

4 (ii) Except for students as noted in subparagraph (iii) of this para-  
5 graph, the base amount as determined from subparagraph (i) of this para-  
6 graph, shall be reduced in relation to income as follows:

7 Amount of income	8 Schedule of reduction of base amount
9 (A) Less than seven thousand 10 dollars	None
11 (B) Seven thousand dollars or 12 more, but less than eleven 13 thousand dollars	Seven per centum of excess over seven thousand dollars
14 (C) Eleven thousand dollars or 15 more, but less than eighteen 16 thousand dollars	Two hundred eighty dollars plus ten per centum of excess over eleven thousand dollars
17 (D) Eighteen thousand dollars or 18 more, but not more than [ <del>eighty</del> 19 <u>one hundred ten</u> 20 thousand dollars	Nine hundred eighty dollars plus twelve per centum of excess over eighteen thousand dollars
21 § 2. This act shall take effect June 1, 2024.
