AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to guidelines for onsite opioid overdose response capacity in community centers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 3 of section 3309 of the 2 public health law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (vi) to read 3 as follows:
- 4 <u>(vi) "Community center" means a facility owned and operated by a</u>
 5 governmental agency or a nonprofit community organization; provided,
 6 that the primary purpose of the facility is for recreation, social
 7 welfare, community improvement or public assembly.
- 8 § 2. Section 3309 of the public health law is amended by adding a new 9 subdivision 8 to read as follows:
- 8. The commissioner shall establish guidelines for onsite opioid overdose response capacity in community centers.
- 12 § 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 13 have become a law.
