AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to retaining peace officer status for parole officers $\frac{1}{2}$

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivision 23 of section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law, as amended by section 70 of subpart B of part C of chapter 62 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 23. Parole officers or warrant officers in the department of corrections and community supervision and offender rehabilitation coor-dinators whose job functions include the following: assigned to one or more of the state's correctional facilities; provide guidance to an assigned caseload of incarcerated individuals and assess needs, prepare evaluations, and prepare eligible incarcerated individuals for release into the community; make recommendations to the board of parole regarding incarcerated individual's readiness for release; perform both social work and law enforcement functions; trained in use of firearms, handle
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

and discharge firearms.
