AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to capping cost sharing for insulin

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph (B) of paragraph 15-a of subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law, as amended by section 1 of part DDD of chapter 56 of the laws of 2020, is amended to read as follows:

4 (B) Such coverage may be subject to annual deductibles and coinsurance 5 as may be deemed appropriate by the superintendent and as are consistent with those established for other benefits within a given policy; б 7 provided however, the total amount that [a covered person] an insured is required to pay out of pocket for covered prescription insulin drugs 8 9 shall be capped in aggregate, including situations where the insured is prescribed more than one insulin drug, at an amount not to exceed [one 10 hundred] thirty dollars per [thirty-day supply] calendar month, regard-11 less of the amount or type of insulin needed to fill such [covered 12 13 person's insured's prescription and regardless of the insured's deduct-14 ible, copayment, coinsurance or any other cost sharing requirement.

15 § 2. Subparagraph (B) of paragraph 7 of subsection (k) of section 3221 16 of the insurance law, as amended by section 2 of part DDD of chapter 56 17 of the laws of 2020, is amended to read as follows:

(B) Such coverage may be subject to annual deductibles and coinsurance as may be deemed appropriate by the superintendent and as are consistent with those established for other benefits within a given policy; provided however, the total amount that [a covered person] an insured is required to pay out of pocket for covered prescription insulin drugs shall be capped in aggregate, including situations where the insured is prescribed more than one insulin drug, at an amount not to exceed [one hundred] thirty dollars per [thirty-day supply] calendar month, regard-

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1 less of the amount or type of insulin needed to fill such [<del>covered</del> 2 <del>person's</del>] <u>insured's</u> prescription and regardless of the insured's deduct-3 ible, copayment, coinsurance or any other cost sharing requirement.

4 § 3. Paragraph 2 of subsection (u) of section 4303 of the insurance 5 law, as amended by section 3 of part DDD of chapter 56 of the laws of 6 2020, is amended to read as follows:

7 (2) Such coverage may be subject to annual deductibles and coinsurance 8 as may be deemed appropriate by the superintendent and as are consistent 9 with those established for other benefits within a given policy; 10 provided however, the total amount that [a covered person] an enrollee 11 is required to pay out of pocket for covered prescription insulin drugs 12 shall be capped in aggregate, including situations where the enrollee is prescribed more than one insulin drug, at an amount not to exceed [one 13 14 hundred] thirty dollars per [thirty-day supply] calendar month, regard-15 less of the amount or type of insulin needed to fill such [govered **person's**] **enrollee's** prescription and regardless of the [**insured's**] 16 17 enrollee's deductible, copayment, coinsurance or any other cost sharing 18 requirement.

19 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to any 20 policy or contract issued, renewed, modified, altered, or amended on or 21 after January 1, 2024.
