AN ACT to allow Benjamin Doty to be eligible to take the civil service exam for the position of deputy sheriff for the Columbia County Sheriff's Office

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 58 of the civil service law or any other provision of law to the contrary, Benjamin Doty, who has been continuously employed by the village of Millerton, in the county of Dutchess, as a part-time police officer, and in the township of Germantown, in the county of Columbia, as a part-time Patrolman, shall be eligible to take the competitive civil service examination for the position of deputy sheriff and shall, contingent upon his score on such examination, be eligible to be placed on the eligible list for appointment as a full-time deputy sheriff for the Columbia county sheriff's office.

- 11 § 2. Benjamin Doty shall otherwise be subject to the merit and fitness 12 provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time deputy sher-13 iffs.
- 14 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
