AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring an operator of a motor vehicle to exercise due care to avoid colliding with a disabled vehicle or a motor vehicle involved in an accident which is parked, stopped, or standing on the shoulder of a highway

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 1144-a of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 458 of the laws of 2011, the section heading as amended and subdivision (c) as added by chapter 97 of the laws of 2016, subdivision (a) as amended by chapter 248 of the laws of 2013, and subdivision (b) as amended by chapter 504 of the laws of 2022, is amended to read as follows:

6 7 § 1144-a. Operation of vehicles when approaching a parked, stopped or standing authorized emergency vehicle [or], hazard vehicle [or], vehicle displaying a blue or green light or disabled vehicle. (a) Every operator 10 of a motor vehicle shall exercise due care to avoid colliding with an 11 authorized emergency vehicle which is parked, stopped or standing on the shoulder or any portion of such highway and such authorized emergency 12 13 vehicle is displaying one or more red or combination red and white lights pursuant to the provisions of paragraph two of subdivision 15 forty-one of section three hundred seventy-five of this chapter or is displaying one or more blue, combination blue and red or combination 16 blue, red and white lights pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph b 17 18 of paragraph four of subdivision forty-one of section three hundred seventy-five of this chapter. For operators of motor vehicles on park-19 20 ways or controlled access highways, such due care shall include, but not 21 be limited to, moving from a lane which contains or is immediately adja-22 cent to the shoulder where such authorized emergency vehicle displaying 23 one or more red, blue or white or any combination of red and white

lights or blue or combination blue and red or combination blue, red and white lights pursuant to the provisions of paragraph two or subparagraph b of paragraph four, as applicable of subdivision forty-one of section three hundred seventy-five of this chapter is parked, stopped or standing to another lane, provided that such movement otherwise complies with the requirements of this chapter including, but not limited to, the provisions of sections eleven hundred ten of this title and eleven hundred twenty-eight of this title.

9 (b) Every operator of a motor vehicle shall exercise due care to avoid 10 colliding with a hazard vehicle which is parked, stopped or standing on 11 shoulder or on any portion of such highway and such hazard vehicle 12 is displaying one or more amber lights pursuant to the provisions of paragraph three of subdivision forty-one of section three hundred seven-13 14 ty-five of this chapter or, if such hazard vehicle is designed for the 15 towing or pushing of disabled vehicles such hazard vehicle is displaying 16 one or more amber lights or one or more blue or combination blue and 17 amber lights pursuant to the provisions of paragraph three or subparagraph b-1 of paragraph four, as applicable, of subdivision forty-one of 18 section three hundred seventy-five of this chapter or, if such hazard 19 20 vehicle owned and operated by the state or by a county, city, town or 21 village is designed for the removal of ice and snow such hazard vehicle is displaying one or more amber lights or one or more green or combination green and amber lights pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 23 three or subparagraph (c) of paragraph five, as applicable, of subdivi-24 25 sion forty-one of section three hundred seventy-five of this chapter. 26 For operators of motor vehicles on parkways or controlled access high-27 ways, such due care shall include, but not be limited to, moving from a 28 lane which contains or is immediately adjacent to the shoulder where (i) 29 such hazard vehicle displaying one or more amber lights pursuant to the 30 provisions of paragraph three of subdivision forty-one of section three 31 hundred seventy-five of this chapter or (ii) such hazard vehicle 32 designed for the towing or pushing of disabled vehicles displaying one 33 or more amber lights or one or more blue or combination blue and amber 34 lights pursuant to the provisions of paragraph three or subparagraph b-1 35 paragraph four, as applicable, of subdivision forty-one of section 36 three hundred seventy-five of this chapter or (iii) such hazard vehicle 37 owned and operated by the state or by a county, city, town or village is displaying one or more amber lights or one or more green or combination 39 green and amber lights pursuant to the provisions of paragraph three or 40 subparagraph (c) of paragraph five, as applicable, of subdivision forty-one of section three hundred seventy-five of this chapter, 41 42 parked, stopped or standing to another lane, provided that such movement 43 otherwise complies with the requirements of this chapter including, but 44 not limited to, the provisions of sections eleven hundred ten and eleven 45 hundred twenty-eight of this title.

(c) Every operator of a motor vehicle shall exercise due care to avoid colliding with a vehicle displaying a blue light pursuant to the provisions of paragraph four or a green light pursuant to the provisions paragraph five of subdivision forty-one of section three hundred seventy-five of this chapter which is parked, stopped or standing on the shoulder or any portion of such highway. For operators of motor vehicles on parkways or controlled access highways, such due care shall include, but not be limited to, moving from a lane which contains or is immediately adjacent to the shoulder where such vehicle displaying a blue light pursuant to the provisions of paragraph four or a green light 56 pursuant to the provisions of paragraph five of subdivision forty-one of

section three hundred seventy-five of this chapter is parked, stopped or standing to another lane, provided that such movement otherwise complies with the requirements of this chapter including, but not limited to, the provisions of sections eleven hundred ten and eleven hundred twentyeight of this title.

(d) Every operator of a motor vehicle shall exercise due care to avoid 7 colliding with a disabled vehicle or a motor vehicle involved in an accident which is parked, stopped or standing on the shoulder or any 8 9 portion of such highway. For operators of motor vehicles on parkways or 10 controlled access highways, such due care shall include, but not be 11 limited to, moving from a lane which contains or is immediately adjacent 12 to the shoulder where such disabled vehicle or motor vehicle involved in an accident is parked, stopped or standing to another lane, provided 13 that such movement otherwise complies with the requirements of this 14 15 chapter including, but not limited to, the provisions of sections eleven hundred ten and eleven hundred twenty-eight of this title. 16

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 18 it shall have become a law.
