AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to permitting the sale of beer at retail on Sundays; and to repeal certain provisions of the alcoholic beverage control law relating thereto

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 105-a of the alcoholic beverage control law is 2 REPEALED.
- 3 § 2. Subdivision 4 of section 34 of the alcoholic beverage control 4 law, as added by chapter 522 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as 5 follows:
 - 4. No tasting shall be held during the hours prohibited by the provisions of [sections] section one hundred five [and one hundred five-a] of this chapter.
- 9 § 3. Subdivision (d) of section 54-b of the alcoholic beverage control law, as added by chapter 232 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read as 11 follows:
- 12 (d) No tasting shall be held during the hours prohibited by the 13 provisions of [$\frac{\text{sections}}{\text{section}}$] $\frac{\text{section}}{\text{section}}$ one hundred five [$\frac{\text{and one hundred}}{\text{five-a}}$] of this chapter.
- 15 § 4. Subdivision (d) of section 59-a of the alcoholic beverage control 16 law, as added by chapter 232 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read as 17 follows:
- 18 (d) No tasting shall be held during the hours prohibited by the 19 provisions of section one hundred five [$\frac{and\ one\ hundred\ five-a}{a}$] of this 20 chapter.
- 21 § 5. Subdivision 6 of section 117-a of the alcoholic beverage control 22 law is REPEALED.

§ 6. Subdivision 4 of section 130 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 186 of the laws of 1949, is amended to read as follows:

- 4. In the city of New York, a summons shall be issued for a violation 5 of the provisions of subdivision fourteen of section one hundred [and] five[- section one hundred and five-a] and subdivision five of section one hundred [and] six of this chapter in the same manner as provided by subdivision h of section one hundred [and] sixteen of the New York city criminal courts act.
- 10 § 7. This act shall take effect immediately.
