AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to providing menstrual products in non-public schools

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 267 of the public health law, as added by section 1 2 of part Q of chapter 56 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as follows:

§ 267. [Feminine hygiene] Menstrual products in schools. All elementary and secondary public schools and non-public schools in the state serving students in any grade from grade six through grade twelve shall provide [feminine hygiene] menstrual products in the restrooms of such school building or buildings. Such products shall be provided at no 9 charge to students.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the first of July next succeeding 10 11 the date on which it shall have become a law.
