AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to certain convictions which shall preclude relicensing of drivers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Subparagraph 3 of paragraph (c) of subdivision 2 of Section 1. 2 section 1193 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 732 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

(3) In no event shall a new license be issued where a person has been 5 twice convicted of a violation of [subdivision] any combination of, subdivision two, two-a, three, four or four-a of section eleven hundred ninety-two of this article [or of driving while intoxicated or of driving while ability is impaired by the use of a drug or of driving while ability is impaired by the combined influence of drugs or of alcohol and 9 10 any drug or drugs, or of section 120.03, 120.04, 120.04-a, 125.12, 11 125.13, or 125.14 of the penal law, where physical injury, as defined in 12 section 10.00 of the penal law, has resulted from such offense in each
