AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to providing home addresses of certain employees to employee organizations

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 1 of section 208 of the civil service law, as added by section 2 of part E of chapter 55 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:

(d) Unless otherwise specified by a collective bargaining agreement,
upon the request of the employee organization, not more than quarterly,
the employer shall provide the employee organization the name, <u>home</u>
address, job title, employing agency or department or other operating
unit and work location of all employees of a bargaining unit. <u>A failure</u>
<u>to comply with this paragraph shall be deemed an improper employer prac-</u>
<u>tice pursuant to paragraph (a) of subdivision one of section two hundred</u>
<u>nine-a of this article.</u>

12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
