AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to information to be provided with all new and renewal leases for certain housing accommodations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph 2 of paragraph i of subdivision 3 of section 467-b of the real property tax law, as added by chapter 424 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read as follows:

(2) a landlord of any housing accommodation subject to provisions of the local emergency housing rent control act, the emergency tenant 6 protection act of nineteen seventy-four or any local laws enacted pursuant thereto, the emergency housing rent control law or the rent stabilization law of nineteen hundred sixty-nine shall, at least [ence] twice 9 annually, [including] provide with [a] all new [lease and all] and 10 renewal leases, and any written lease modifications, delivered to the occupant of such accommodation, [provide] the informational material 11 describing eligibility for and the benefits of the senior citizen rent 12 increase exemption program and the disability rent increase exemption 13 14 program, as provided by the entity administering the program pursuant to 15 subparagraph one of this paragraph; provided however, that any such 16 information provided as part of a new or renewal lease, or written lease modification, shall count toward the requirement for two annual notices. 17 18 § 2.
