AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the offense of obstructing a police officer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 195.09 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 195.09 Obstructing a police officer.
- A person is guilty of obstructing a police officer when he or she intentionally interferes with, inhibits, or attempts to interfere with or inhibit, a police officer or a peace officer from engaging in the course of performing their official duties, including but not limited to:
- 9 <u>1. spitting, throwing or spilling items, liquid or otherwise, at or on</u>
 10 <u>such officer; or</u>
- 11 <u>2. pushing, shoving, kicking, physically impeding or otherwise</u> 12 <u>subjecting such officer to physical contact.</u>
- 13 Obstructing a police officer is a class E felony.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
- 15 have become a law.
