AN ACT to amend the civil rights law, in relation to enacting the "traveling with dignity act"

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "traveling with dignity act".
- 3 § 2. The civil rights law is amended by adding a new section 79-r to 4 read as follows:
- 5 § 79-r. Adult changing accommodations. 1. As used in this section, the following terms shall have the following meanings:
- 7 (a) "Adult changing accommodation" means a height-adjustable adult
  8 changing table placed within an enclosed restroom facility or other
  9 similar private facility that is for use by persons with disabilities
  10 who need help with diapering.
- 11 (b) "Commercial place of public amusement" means an auditorium, 12 convention center, cultural complex, exhibition hall, permanent amuse-13 ment park, sports arena, or theater or movie house for which the maximum 14 occupancy is determined to be two thousand five hundred or more people.
- 15 <u>(c) "Covered facility" means a commercial place of public amusement,</u> 16 <u>public roadside rest area with sanitary facilities, museum, public</u> 17 <u>library or other public building.</u>
- 18 (d) "Disability" shall have the same meaning as provided for in subdi-19 vision twenty-one of section two hundred ninety-two of the executive 20 law.
- 21 <u>(e) "Public building" means a public building owned by the state of</u>
  22 New York, under the supervision and control of the commissioner of

1 general services, that is determined by such commissioner to be open to 2 the public.

- 2. (a) A covered facility shall install and maintain at least one adult changing accommodation for persons with a physical disability that is accessible to both men and women when the facility is open to the public, if any of the following occur:
- (i) The covered facility is newly constructed on or after January first, two thousand twenty-five;
- 9 <u>(ii) When an existing covered facility is renovated on or after Janu-</u>
  10 <u>ary first, two thousand twenty-five, and either requires a permit or the</u>
  11 <u>estimated cost of the renovation is ten thousand dollars or more; or</u>
- 12 <u>(iii) If neither subparagraph (i) or (ii) of this paragraph apply, in</u>
  13 <u>the case of:</u>
- 14 <u>(1) a covered facility that is a public building, no later than Janu-</u> 15 <u>ary first, two thousand twenty-eight;</u>
- 16 (2) a covered facility that is a museum or public library, no later
  17 than January first, two thousand thirty; or
- 18 <u>(3) a covered facility that is a commercial place of public amusement,</u> 19 <u>no later than January first, two thousand thirty-two; or</u>
- 20 (b) A covered facility with an enclosed restroom facility or other 21 similar private facility with an adult changing table in use before 22 January first, two thousand twenty-five, shall be deemed to comply with 23 this subdivision.
- 3. A covered facility shall ensure that the entrance to each adult changing accommodation has conspicuous signage indicating the location of the accommodation, and, if the facility has a central directory, shall ensure that the central directory indicates the location of the adult changing accommodation.
  - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
