Introduced by Sens. PARKER, HARCKHAM, HOYLMAN-SIGAL, JACKSON, MAY, SKOUFIS -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Environmental Conservation

AN ACT directing the commissioner of the department of environmental conservation to promulgate rules and regulations establishing targets for the sales of zero emissions medium and heavy duty vehicles in the state

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of the department of environmental conservation shall, within 180 days of the effective date of this act, promulgate rules and regulations, which may include the updating of existing regulations, which establish targets for the sales of zero emissions medium and heavy duty vehicles in the state. Such standards shall contain the same sales targets, fleet percentages, and credit calculations for zero emissions medium and heavy duty vehicles as set forth in regulations adopted by the state of California.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
