- AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to requiring the chair and commissioners of the state liquor authority to file certain disclosures

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 11 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as 2 amended by section 2 of part E of chapter 57 of the laws of 2011, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 § 11. Appointment of authority. The members of the authority shall be 5 appointed by the governor by and with the advice and consent of the senate. Not more than two members of the authority shall belong to the б same political party. The [chairman] chair of the state alcoholic bever-7 8 age control board heretofore appointed and designated by the governor 9 and the remaining members of such board heretofore appointed by the governor shall continue to serve as [chairman] chair and members of the 10 11 authority until the expiration of the respective terms for which they Upon the expiration of such respective terms the 12 were appointed. successors of such [chairman] chair and members shall be appointed to 13 14 serve for a term of three years each and until their successors have 15 been appointed and qualified. The commissioners, other than the [chair-16 **man**] chair shall, when performing the work of the authority, be compensated at a rate of two hundred sixty dollars per day, together with an 17 18 allowance for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties. The [chairman] chair shall receive an annual salary estab-19 20 lished in section one hundred sixty-nine of the executive law. Notwith-21 standing any provision of law to the contrary, the chair and each 22 commissioner shall be required to file an annual statement of financial disclosure pursuant to section seventy-three-a of the public officers 23 24 law.

25 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
