AN ACT relating to requiring the chief administrator of the courts, in conjunction with the office of information technology services, to develop a portal for the exchange of discovery in criminal cases

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The chief administrator of the courts, in conjunction with
2 the office of information technology services, shall establish a state-
3 wide strategy plan under which a statewide electronic portal shall be
4 developed and made available through the unified court system to enable
5 district attorneys, institutional defense providers, private attorneys
6 and assigned counsel to provide required discovery disclosure to oppos-
7 ing counsel in criminal cases. The portal shall be available for use no
8 later than January 1, 2025.
9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
