AN ACT to amend the insurance law and the social services law, in relation to mandatory health insurance coverage for lung cancer screening

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 39 to read as follows:

(39) (A) Every policy which provides medical, major medical, or similar comprehensive-type coverage shall provide coverage for follow-up screening for lung cancer when recommended by a health care provider acting within the provider's scope of practice pursuant to title eight of the education law.

(B) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any policy that provides coverage required by this paragraph shall not impose patient cost sharing for follow-up screening for lung cancer.

§ 2. Subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 22 to read as follows:

(22) (A) Every policy which provides medical, major medical, or similar comprehensive-type coverage shall provide coverage for follow-up screening for lung cancer when recommended by a health care provider acting within the provider's scope of practice pursuant to title eight of the education law.

(B) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any policy that provides coverage required by this paragraph shall not impose patient cost sharing for follow-up screening for lung cancer.

§ 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subsection (vv) to read as follows:

13 pursuant to title eight of the education law.

14 (ii) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, coverage required by
15 this paragraph shall not impose patient cost sharing for follow-up
16 screening for lung cancer.

17 § 5. This act shall take effect January 1, 2026 and shall apply to all
18 policies and contracts issued, renewed, modified, altered or amended on
19 or after such date.
