AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring electronic benefit transfer systems to include fraud detection for unauthorized transactions

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 8 <u>be completed if such transaction is being made in a state other than New</u>
