Introduced by Sen. ADDABBO -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Racing, Gaming and Wagering

AN ACT to amend the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, in relation to allowing season-long proposition bets and future award winners as authorized bets

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (x) of subdivision 1 of section 1367 of the  
2 racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, as amended by section 3  
3 of part Y of chapter 59 of the laws of 2021, is amended to read as  
4 follows:

5 (x) "Sports wagering" means wagering on sporting events or any portion  
6 thereof, or on the individual performance statistics of athletes partic-  
7 ipating in a sporting event, or combination of sporting events, by any  
8 system or method of wagering, including, but not limited to, in-person  
9 communication and electronic communication through internet websites  
10 accessed via a mobile device or computer, and mobile device applica-  
11 tions; provided however that sports wagers shall include, but are not  
12 limited to, single-game bets, teaser bets, parlays, over-under bets,  
13 money line, pools, in-game wagering, in-play bets, in-game and season-  
14 long proposition bets, and straight bets; and season award winners;  
15 provided however, that such in-game and season-long proposition bets and  
16 season award winners wagers shall be limited to those wagers that are  
17 performance-based unless such wagers were otherwise authorized by the  
18 commission as of the effective date of the chapter of the laws of two  
19 thousand twenty-four that amended this paragraph; and provided further,  
20 that coin toss bets that affect the gameplay of an event shall be  
21 permitted at all sporting events unless prohibited by the commission;

22 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
