AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to loss prevention programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subsection (f) of section 2324 of the insurance law is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (f) This section shall not prohibit any insurer from providing loss
 4 mitigation or loss control programs at no or reduced cost to policyhold5 ers, pursuant to regulations promulgated by the superintendent.
- 6 (g) Any person or corporation violating the provisions of this section 7 shall, in addition to all other penalties provided by law, pay to the 8 people of this state as a penalty the sum of five hundred dollars for 9 each such violation.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
