AN ACT in relation to directing the commissioner of health to conduct a sickle cell disparity study; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. 1. The commissioner of health is authorized and directed to 2 conduct a sickle cell disparity study.

3 2. Such study shall determine whether there is a disparity between 4 treatment accessibility and affordability for persons with sickle cell 5 disease and persons with other chronic illnesses, including but not 6 limited to lupus, cancer, diabetes, and heart disease.

3. Not later than eighteen months after the effective date of this
act, the commissioner shall post the results of such study on the open
health data section of the department of health's website.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 11 deemed repealed two years after such effective date.
