- AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to real property tax exemptions for veterans

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 458-a of the real property tax law, as amended by chapter 473 of the laws of 2004, is amended to read as follows:

(b) In addition to the exemption provided by paragraph (a) of this 4 5 subdivision, where the veteran served in a combat theatre or combat zone of operations, as documented by the award of a United States campaign 6 7 ribbon or service medal, or the armed forces expeditionary medal, navy 8 expeditionary medal, marine corps expeditionary medal, or global war on 9 terrorism expeditionary medal, or where the veteran served on a subma-10 rine or on classified missions during a period of war as documented by 11 **military service records**, qualifying residential real property also 12 shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of ten percent of the 13 assessed value of such property; provided, however, that such exemption 14 shall not exceed eight thousand dollars or the product of eight thousand 15 dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the assess-16 ing unit, or in the case of a special assessing unit, the class ratio, 17 whichever is less.
