AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to exempting certain persons from the crime of criminal possession of a firearm, rifle or shotgun in a sensitive location

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraphs (n) and (o) of subdivision 3 of section 265.01-e
2 of the penal law, paragraph (n) as amended and paragraph (o) as added by
3 section 1 of part F of chapter 55 of the laws of 2023, are amended and a
4 new paragraph (p) is added to read as follows:

5 (n) persons while participating in military ceremonies, funerals, and
6 honor guards; ~~[-]~~

7 (o) persons while lawfully engaging in learning, practicing, training
8 for, competing in, or travelling into or within the state to learn,
9 practice, train for, or compete in, the sport of biathlon, in accordance
10 with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, rules, and regu-
11 lations~~[-]~~; or

12 (p) persons who are retired judges of the court of appeals, justices
13 of the supreme court, judges of the court of claims, judges of the
14 county court, judges of the surrogate's court, judges of the family
15 court, judges of a court for the city of New York, judges of the
16 district court, and judges of a city court outside of the city of New
17 York, and who are duly licensed to possess a pistol or revolver pursuant
18 to section 400.00 of this chapter.

19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
