AN ACT to amend chapter 53 of the laws of 2024, enacting the aid to localities budget, in relation to authorizing funding that would include services and expenses intended to result in improved compliance with fair housing laws

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 53 of the laws of 2024, enacting the
2 aid to localities budget, is amended by repealing the items herein
3 below set forth in brackets and by adding to such section the other
4 items underscored in this section:

7 FAIR HOUSING TESTING

8 General Fund

9 Local Assistance Account - 10000

10 For services and expenses of fair housing
