AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to allowing advanced emergency medical technicians to order certain controlled substances for use by a person with a substance use disorder to relieve acute withdrawal symptoms

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 3351 of the public health law, as
- 2 added by chapter 878 of the laws of 1972, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 2. Controlled substances may be ordered for use by [~~an addict~~] a
- 4 person with a substance use disorder or habitual user by a practitioner
- 5 and administered by a practitioner [~~or~~], registered nurse, or advanced
- 6 emergency medical technician to relieve acute withdrawal symptoms.
- 7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION--Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [~~-~~] is old law to be omitted.

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
