Introduced by M. of A. ROSENTHAL, KELLES -- read once and referred to the Committee on Agriculture

AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to establishing animals as sentient beings

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new
2 section 386 to read as follows:

3 § 386. Animals as sentient beings. The Legislature finds and declares
4 that animals are sentient beings capable of experiencing pain, stress,
5 and fear. It is the policy of New York that, in order to protect animals
6 from experiencing pain, stress, or fear at human hands, animals are to
7 be treated humanely. For that reason, animals shall be considered the
8 victims of animal cruelty crimes and shall be treated as such in a court
9 of law.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
