AN ACT to allow Steven Kobie Jackson to be eligible to take the civil service exam for the position of police officer for the town of Woodstock police department

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 58 of the civil
2 service law or any other provision of law to the contrary, Steven Kobie
3 Jackson, who has been continuously employed by the town of Woodstock
4 police department, in the county of Ulster, as a part-time police officer,
5 shall be eligible to take the competitive civil service examination
6 for the position of police officer and shall, contingent upon his score
7 on such examination, be eligible to be placed on the eligible list for
8 appointment as a full-time police officer for the town of Woodstock
9 police department.
- 10 § 2. Steven Kobie Jackson shall otherwise be subject to the merit and
11 fitness provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time
12 police officers.
- 13 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
