AN ACT to amend the social services law and the public health law, in relation to requiring all employees of a child day care to be trained in administering an opioid antagonist

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 390-a of the social services law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:

3 6. a. Every employee of a family day care home, group family day care
4 home, school-age child care program and child day care center shall
5 receive training in the administration of an opioid antagonist pursuant
6 to a program approved under section thirty-three hundred nine of the
7 public health law.

8 b. Every child day care center, family day care home, group family day
9 care home and school-age child care program shall stock at least one
10 opioid antagonist as defined in section thirty-three hundred nine of the
11 public health law.

12 § 2. Subparagraph (v) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 3 of section
13 3309 of the public health law, as added by chapter 148 of the laws of
14 2020, is amended to read as follows:

15 (v) As used in this section, "entity" includes, but is not limited to,
16 a school district, public library, board of cooperative educational
17 services, county vocational education and extension board, charter
18 school, non-public elementary or secondary school, child day care
19 center, family day care home, group family day care home, school-age
20 child care program, restaurant, bar, retail store, shopping mall, barber
21 shop, beauty parlor, theater, sporting or event center, inn, hotel or
22 motel.

23 § 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after
24 it shall have become a law.
