AN ACT in relation to authorizing Christopher Walser and Matthew Patire to each take the competitive civil service examination for the position of police officer and be placed on the eligible list for employment as a full-time police officer for the village of Skaneateles police department

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 58 of the civil
2 service law, including the age requirements under paragraph (a) of
3 subdivision 1 of such section, or any other provision of law to the
4 contrary, Christopher Walser and Matthew Patire shall each be eligible
5 to take the competitive civil service examination for the position of
6 police officer and shall, contingent upon their scores on such examina-
7 tion, each be eligible to be placed on the eligible list for appointment
8 as a full-time police officer for the village of Skaneateles police
9 department.
- 10 § 2. Christopher Walser and Matthew Patire shall otherwise be subject
11 to the merit and fitness provisions of the civil service law applicable
12 to full-time police officers.
- 13 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
