AN ACT to amend chapter 658 of the laws of 1991 establishing a library district in the village of Mamaroneck, Westchester county, in relation to the number of members of the board of trustees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph c of subdivision 1 of section 2 of chapter 658 of  
2 the laws of 1991 establishing a library district in the village of  
3 Mamaroneck, Westchester county is amended to read as follows:

4 c. The election of [~~eleven~~ nine] trustees as hereinafter provided.

5 § 2. Section 3 of chapter 658 of the laws of 1991 establishing a  
6 library district in the village of Mamaroneck, Westchester county is  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 § 3. Organization and structure. The Mamaroneck public library  
9 district shall be managed, operated and controlled by a board of trus-  
10 tees consisting of [~~eleven~~ nine] members. These trustees shall at the  
11 first regular meeting of the board determine by lot the year in which  
12 each of their terms of office expire, and the terms shall expire as  
13 follows: after one year- three trustees; after two years- four trus-  
14 tees; after three years- four trustees. As vacancies occur, trustees  
15 shall be elected at the annual election herein provided for to serve for  
16 three year terms by the voters of the library district hereby created,  
17 with each such trustee eligible to serve for a maximum of three consec-  
18 utive terms. Each term shall commence on the first day of June next  
19 following the election. Only qualified voters of the district shall be  
20 eligible for election to the board of trustees. The board of trustees at  
21 its first meeting each year shall elect or appoint a president and vice-  
22 president who shall be members of the board and clerk, treasurer and  
23 other such officers as they deem necessary. If the board so determines,  
24 the offices of clerk and treasurer may be held by individuals who are

1 not members of the board of trustees and, in that event, such officers  
2 may, if the board so determines, receive compensation as fixed by resol-  
3 ution of the board.  
4 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
