

Assembly Resolution No. 1625

Such plan shall be subject to the approval of the Speaker of the Assembly and the director of the budget and thereafter shall be included in a resolution calling for the expenditure of such monies, which resolution must be approved by a majority vote of all members elected to the Assembly upon a roll call vote, in accordance with the following schedule:
