WHEREAS, Louis Coppola's commitment to excellence, and his spirit of humanity, carried over into all fields of enterprise, including charitable and civic endeavors; and

WHEREAS, Louis Coppola is survived by his brother, William; his sister, Marie Olivier; nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews that he deeply cherished; he was predeceased by his parents and older brother, Anthony; and

WHEREAS, Armed with a humanistic spirit and imbued with a sense of compassion, Louis Coppola leaves behind a legacy which will long endure the passage of time and will remain as a comforting memory to all he served and befriended; now, therefore, be it
