WHEREAS, Mary Piven began her entrepreneurial career in 2008 when she launched Center Clean in Kyiv, Ukraine, building the company through diligence, discipline, and a culture of excellence that quickly earned the trust of residential and commercial clients alike; and

WHEREAS, In 2014, motivated by a bold vision for growth and global impact, Mary Piven relocated to the United States, bringing with her academic degrees in pedagogy and economics and a steadfast belief in the transformative power of education, perseverance, and entrepreneurship; and

WHEREAS, In 2016, Mary Piven founded Clean2Clean in New York City, expanding the company from a modest residential service into a highly respected contractor, which serves business and government partners, earning Women Business Enterprise (WBE), Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE), and School Construction Authority (SCA) certifications; and
