

Senate Resolution No. 1978

WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to commend the Grand Lecturers of the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodges of New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania upon the occasion of hosting their Tri-State Regional Education Seminar on Saturday, May 9, 2026, in Mount Vernon, New York; and
