HONORING Oscar Lin upon the occasion of his designation as recipient of the New York State Citizenship Award

WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to honor Oscar Lin upon the occasion of his designation as recipient of the New York State Citizenship Award, to be recognized on May 19, 2026, at East Meadow High School in East Meadow, New York; and

WHEREAS, The New York State Citizenship Award is bestowed upon students who embody the highest principles of civic responsibility, integrity, and dedication to the common good, serving as role models who strengthen the fabric of their communities through their actions, conduct, and example; and
