WHEREAS, America has achieved its greatest heights of glory through the dedication, determination and tireless efforts of the outstanding citizens of this Nation; and

WHEREAS, He demonstrated exceptional initiative and civic responsibility by raising the resources necessary for his Eagle Scout project through organizing a beach cleanup fundraiser and securing support from family and friends, thereby contributing to the beautification and betterment of the community; and

WHEREAS, James Griffith began his Scouting journey in elementary school as a Cub Scout in Pack 101, and after earning the Arrow of Light, the highest honor in Cub Scouting, joined Troop 71 where he demonstrated leadership, service, and perseverance; and

WHEREAS, Through his years in Scouting, James Griffith developed a

deep appreciation for the outdoors and built lasting memories through weekend campouts, summer camping at Onteora Scout Reservation, hikes, and evenings spent around the campfire with fellow Scouts; and

WHEREAS, James graduated from Manhasset High School in 2025, where he excelled academically through numerous Honors and Advanced Placement courses and participated in the Cross Country and Track and Field teams, as well as the Engineering Club; and
