WHEREAS, Joseph R. Arcara has been a member of the American Legion for over 75 years, and he served in many officer positions, including Post Commander of the Rouf Norreli-Hardgrove Post 632 on 101st Avenue in Ozone Park; and

WHEREAS, In addition to being a longtime member of the Catholic War Veterans, Joseph R. Arcara has served his Nativity B.V.N. Church and community for over 45 years as an usher, member of the Holy Name Society, and volunteer at the annual Nativity Bazaar Bingo event; and

WHEREAS, Residents of this great State must never forget the courage with which these men and women served their country; and

WHEREAS, Having exhibited his patriotism both at home and abroad, Joseph R. Arcara demonstrated his love for his country and merits forevermore the highest respect of his State and Nation; and
