WHEREAS, Utilizing a trauma-informed approach, ACBC ensures that clients receive compassionate care that addresses both addiction and its root causes, helping to build a foundation for lasting recovery; it offers Health Home Care Management, which connects clients to medical, housing, and social services, as well as peer recovery programs; and

WHEREAS, ACBC works across Broome and surrounding counties, including locations in Binghamton and Endicott, to make treatment accessible throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, Committed to removing barriers to treatment, The Addiction Center of Broome County offers a sliding fee scale to ensure that no one is denied care due to financial limitations; and

WHEREAS, By combining evidence-based practices with human connection, ACBC continues to serve as a trusted provider of addiction treatment and recovery support; and

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body recognizes the vital importance of The Addiction Center of Broome County in providing excellence in care through prevention, education and treatment, and its evident commitment to this mission; now, therefore, be it
