**WHEREAS,** The Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem M. Schneerson proclaimed that the time of the Redemption has arrived and "Moshiach Is On The Way" and called upon all citizens of the world to prepare with a personal commitment to increase all activities of goodness and kindness; and

**WHEREAS,** Today, in the United States of America, the Chabad Lubavitch movement has centers and institutions in every State of the Union; and
