the State of New York

WHEREAS, For many Spanish-speaking New Yorkers, "locutores" serve as trusted voices who deliver news, culture, entertainment, and critical public information in their native language; and

WHEREAS, New York State is home to one of the largest and most vibrant Latino communities in the nation and Spanish-language broadcasters are essential in ensuring that residents remain informed about public safety, civic engagement, elections, health resources, and community events; and
