WHEREAS, Rocket Maxwell Easton Streich learned how to be a leader of large groups of people by serving as both Senior Patrol Leader as well as Webmaster for Troop 28 and he put his outdoor skills to the test by attending Camp Read Reservation for several summers, where he honed many abilities and became a well-rounded, educated citizen; and
