MEMORIALIZING Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim October 25-31, 2026, as Respiratory Care Week in the State of New York

WHEREAS, Encouraging therapists and departments to organize events and festivities within their workplaces and communities in order to help to celebrate, motivate and encourage patients and their families in their battles against lung disease; educate by taking awareness of lung diseases like COPD and asthma to the community; inspire by building the desire in others to enter the respiratory care profession; and learn by maximizing personal and professional skills with new resources; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that there be greater public awareness of this serious health issue and more must be done to increase activity at the local, State and national levels; now, therefore, be it
