**MEMORIALIZING** Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim October 2026, as Careers in Construction Month in the State of New York

**WHEREAS,** Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to memorialize Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim October 2026 as Careers in Construction Month in the State of New York, in conjunction with the observance of National Careers in Construction Month; and

**WHEREAS,** Careers in Construction Month is an annual month designated to increase public awareness and appreciation of construction craft professionals and the entire construction workforce; and

**WHEREAS,** During this month, employers, associations and schools are encouraged to conduct job fairs, panel discussions, and local community events to inform students of the vast employment opportunities in construction; and

**WHEREAS,** The construction industry is one of our nation's largest industries and is the backbone of all U.S. infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS,** As of January 2023, approximately 7.8 million people are employed by the construction industry, which makes up about 2.9% of the U.S. workforce; and

**WHEREAS,** This Legislative Body is pleased to honor the construction craft professionals and the critical role they play in the development of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to memorialize Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim October 2026, as Careers in Construction Month in the State of New York; and be it further
