**CONGRATULATING** Samantha Massey upon the occasion of capturing the NYSPHSAA's Section III Girls Wrestling Championship

**WHEREAS,** This win capped an impressive season for Samantha Massey, who finished her first varsity year with a 39-2 record, remaining undefeated against other girls; her quick rise and dominance in the tournament makes her one of the standout athletes in the area; and

**WHEREAS,** Samantha Massey's title added to the strong presence of Section III athletes at the inaugural state championship, further solidifying her place among the top female wrestlers in New York State; and

**WHEREAS,** The athletic talent displayed by this scholar athlete is due in great part to the efforts of a great team of coaches, including Mount Markham's John Hoke and Brandon Yager, and her Club Coach Laken Cook, skilled and inspirational tutors, respected for their ability to develop potential into excellence; and

**WHEREAS,** In light of her recent accomplishments, Samantha Massey has brought honor and just pride to her school and community on the local, and State level, clearly utilizing dedication, determination and teamwork in providing a lasting contribution to the spirit of excellence which is a tradition of her school; now, therefore, be it
