WHEREAS, Although Chinese railroad workers were essential for the success of the Transcontinental railroad, no Chinese laborers were formally recognized at the opening ceremony; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that the State of New York commemorates and recognizes the historical contributions made by the Chinese railroad workers; by honoring these individuals and their families, we seek to uplift their stories, honor their contributions, and express our sincerest gratitude for their efforts; and

WHEREAS, It is the pleasure of this Legislative Body to participate in the Chinese Railroad worker exhibition in Albany, New York on Wednesday, May 14, 2025, and to recognize the descendants of the estimated 15,000 to 20,000 Chinese immigrants whom, despite remarkable physical and social challenges, laid the foundation for extraordinary economic prosperity for New York State and the Nation as a whole; now, therefore, be it
