**WHEREAS,** With the help of the Hillside Children's Center, Erie County Child Protective Services, Trinity United Methodist Church, and Church of Nativity UCC, Kit Panna was able to create 350 bags for children, far exceeding their initial goal of 200; and

**WHEREAS,** This outstanding young individual has been involved in

Scouting for years, has lived up to Scouting's ideals, and has attained all the necessary achievements; and

**WHEREAS,** Kit Panna is a credit to their family, their school, their community, their State, and their Nation, and there is no doubt that their future will be filled with accomplishments of equal importance; now, therefore, be it
