May 2025, as Teen Self-Esteem Month in the State of

WHEREAS, Additionally, bullying and teasing are issues which can lead to low self-esteem, furthering the importance of adults praising teens more than scolding them; and

WHEREAS, There are several tangible and profound ways in which we can help our teens, such as encouraging them to be active, persuading them to try something new, helping them to nurture friendships, tackling to do lists and helping them to identify things in which they excel; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that there be greater public awareness of this serious issue, and more must be done to increase knowledge and attentiveness at both the state and local levels to support and protect our youth, our most precious resource; now, therefore, be it
