WHEREAS, Funds raised at the Buddy Walk have a direct impact on individuals with Down syndrome and their families within the local communities at any stage of life which includes parental education, professional education, Modified Curricular Units provided to Capital Region school districts, and much, much more; and

WHEREAS, The Down Syndrome Aim High Resource Center has been steadfast in its mission to provide parent-to-parent and professional services and support to individuals with Down syndrome and their families and to educate the broader community on Down syndrome; and
