WHEREAS, After working in private practice for 35 years, where he specialized in litigation, Loren Lobban was appointed to the New York State Workers' Compensation Board in 2010; for approximately 15 years on the Board, he served with the utmost distinction and integrity, working in support of the Board's mission; his meaningful work touched the lives of countless individuals; and

WHEREAS, Loren Lobban had many years of experience as a practicing attorney, representing individuals, businesses, and government; he was the principle of his own firm and Counsel to the Erie County Legislature; he also volunteered his time, representing clients for the Erie County Bar Association Volunteer Lawyers Project; and

WHEREAS, Loren Lobban always acted with conviction and a deep commitment to his community; and

WHEREAS, Armed with a humanistic spirit and imbued with a sense of compassion, Loren Lobban leaves behind a legacy which will long endure the passage of time and will remain as a comforting memory to all he served and befriended; now, therefore, be it
