WHEREAS, Without the proper care and affection during these initial five years, a child can become depressed, restless, and attention-starved, leading them to seek out solace from dangerous situations; and

WHEREAS, It is the practice of this Legislative Body to recognize those vital days which remind us of the importance of establishing a foundation of mental health for all adults; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to memorialize Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim June 12-16, 2025, as Infant Mental Health Awareness Week in the State of New York; and be it further
